- Envirocare are currently willing to cut the grass. The first cut occurred on the 27th March, which included the whole burial ground.
- Lancaster City Council have sent a letter indicating that their teams are only carrying-out essential work, so St Wilfrid's Park is unlikely to be cut in the foreseeable future.

It was resolved: that the Clerk asks Envirocare to cut St Wilfrid's Park temporarily.

It was resolved: that the Clerk asks the groundsmen keep the grass under control on the recreational area and around the Centre.

b) HCA Report

It closed on 22nd March. Signs have been put up informing that the play areas are closed. It is being used by a local group to create scrubs for the RLI.

c) Finance Report

This report covers the year end for 2020-21 and the start of the new financial year. The year-end figures will be finalised when the Annual Governance and Audit Report (AGAR) is produced, but the provisional balance is £12,202.06.

The AGAR deadline appears to have been extended by 2 months, but this has yet to be officially confirmed by the external auditor. No internal audit has yet occurred; it is difficult to see how this can occur during lockdown, especially because both other clerks are in the at-risk group.

The precept has yet to be received, so the financial statement for 15th April indicates a negative General A/C balance; this will be rectified once the precept is received.

The VAT claim for the period ending 31st March has been completed.
